Latest news from Kerry: "Our team is thankful for the opportunities we get to pray for people, show the love of Jesus in helping with medical needs and offering them Good News. It seems that every day there are new opportunities. 'Y' (a Fulbe believer for one year) continues to share what he is learning with a group of seven friends; another Bible study group has also started from this group. He also gets other opportunities to challenge people about their view of Jesus and the Bible. His courage and faith are growing all the time.

A young Fulbe woman, Eve, committed her life to Jesus a month ago. She is now getting ready to tell her muslim family about this and she is expecting a violent reaction from her father. But Eve is convinced that she needs to tell her family as she doesn't want to be ashamed of her new joy and faith. Her joy and bravery is

As more and more Fulbe come to Christ, there is more and more persecution. This comes in the form of social isolation, mockery, economic hardship as they are no longer welcomed as part of the community, and sometimes violence and 'imprisonment' in their own homes.

Our hospital in the far north continues to do well, with increased numbers of patients coming again as the security improves. But we still lack a skilled surgeon and the need is great. Discipling Fulbe believers in the far north of Cameroon is not always easy as we are so far away from them and are reliant on phone conversations with them "
