This week **Peter Landry** and **David Farnworth** head to Thailand to serve our Mission Partners Malcolm and Kerstin Gray and the 40 missionaries they lead. Peter and David will run the youth and kids programmes at WEC Thailand's annual conference to refresh and renew the missionaries.



In April **Michael Holmes** spent 5 days on the Ibiza 24-7 prayer team. Michael and the team were preparing the ground in prayer for the thousands of young people who will visit the island in the summer – praying for the teams who will be reaching out to them.
