Pedro and Annu Santos and their sons Daniel and Yonatan live in Tel Aviv, Israel. They serve at Beit Immanuel which has a guest house and is home to two Messianic congregations.

Latest news from Pedro and Annu:

God is doing amazing things at Beit Immanuel with people coming to faith all the time. There are three Jewish Brazilian families who have come to faith this year, and are growing in their faith. However the husbands have not yet made a commitment to Jesus. Pray that they will see the witness of their families and come to know Jesus for themselves.

Continue to pray for Yonatan, Gabi and Yochana, who are people the Santos family are regularly in touch with but who are not Christians yet, that they will continue to have opportunities to talk about and discuss the bible and Jesus with them, and that through these conversations they would come to Jesus for salvation.

Pedro writes "We so much appreciate all you do for us. Your love is something we cannot take for granted. Thank you so much for your prayers. We also pray for St Barnabas and all that you are involved with, especially the big move to Solar House."

Give thanks for:

- The three Jewish Brazilian families believing in Jesus and being a witness to the rest of their family.
- The opportunities the Santos family have to discuss the Bible and Jesus with non-believers.
- For all the prayer and support that the Santos family have.

Please pray for:

- The Holy Spirit to reveal who Jesus is to the husbands in the Brazilian Jewish families and to give Pedro and others the words to share with them.
- Yonatan, Gabi and Yochanan - that the truth they heard through conversations about the Bible would resonate with them, and that the Holy Spirit would reveal the truth of Jesus to them.
