Jo Jowett

Jo Jowett lives in Birmingham with her husband, Mark, and works for Global Connections - an organisation that promotes and facilitates mission in the UK and overseas. Jo and Global Connections fulfil a vital role in resourcing mission around the world.

Since Jo's last prayer update, she has had a very busy summer season of events where Christian Vocations runs SERVICEstation, an advice service for large Christian events to help visitors seeking help with vocational issues and service opportunities. Jo's mobilisation activities have continued, including production of the 2018 edition of SERVEshort-term, the development of regional mission agency partnerships, managing large event relationships, all with a new boss, which inevitably brings about some change.

Jo chairs a partnership of mission agencies that run GOfest, a movement of mission-focused agencies and churches who together want to see UK Christians fully engaged in the Great Commission. Follow-up with local churches is ongoing following the first 'new' GOfest event in May. The next event will be at All Nations Christian College on 12 May 2018.

Mark's business is now one year old and going well. The increased flexibility this has given Mark has meant he has been able to assist Jo in some of her work, particularly during the event season.

City Pastors continues to be a great opportunity to engage with Birmingham's night-time economy, though more people are needed for the next training at the end of October.

Jo has just recovered from a back injury over the summer and has now had a fall, necessitating crutches having sustained an ankle ligament injury.
