They are currently living in a WEC property, but are trying to sell a property in Bristol in order to buy a house in Coventry. However the market is slow at the moment.

After a whirlwind transition this year, when energy levels at times have been low, they are slowly regaining strength and motivation for the next

They hope to have a clear idea of what their new roles within WEC UK will be by the end of the WEC conference on 20-23 October. They will return to full-time ministry by the beginning of 2019.
