John and Suzi Peachey are serving with Youth with A Mission (YWAM) in Harpenden. They teach and mentor younger missionary leaders, and help facilitate the group of senior leaders caring for YWAM teams in England. They lead the ministry of *Orphans Know More* which is strengthening Ugandan families who have adopted orphans. Their four young adult children are Seth, Joel, Naomi and Lily. John is working towards a PhD through the Oxford Centre for Mission Studies and Middlesex University.

Latest news from John and Suzi:

John was in Uganda last week doing an audit of Orphans Know More (OKM). One of the highlights was meeting with a group of people who OKM have assisted, who are now grown up and in work. Rose, a 4 year old HIV positive girl, lost both her parents in South Sudan. She is now adopted and was seen happy and smiling.

Suzi and John support the leadership teams of YWAM Cambridge and Harpenden. Both locations are buzzing with missionary trainees doing courses on discipleship, the Bible, communications and international relations and diplomacy.

John is helping lead two Masters in Christian Formation and Discipleship with the Christian university, University of the Nations, and is in Switzerland this week. He supervises six Masters projects and theses.

John is aiming to finish his PhD theses in Education by the end of 2019.

Suzi is connecting people with OKM and a new project, Wholehearted Child, to help school-age children and their families become aware of the lives of children and families in Uganda. She plays a big role in local fundraising events for OKM.

Three of the Peachey children led a university outreach team to Uganda this summer, planting trees, sharing in prisons and teaming up with students from Uganda Christian University to share the good news at an agricultural show.

Naomi is running No Makeup November 2018 to raise funds for the education of 67 Ugandan girls for a year. She has information on Youtube, Facebook and Justgiving.

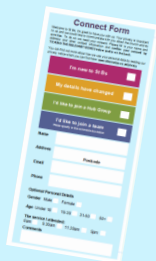
