**Ann-Marie Wilson** is the founding Executive Director of the charity *28 Too Many* which has the ambitious goal of reducing Female Genital Mutilation (FGM) by 10% in 10 countries in 10 years. She is also a Pioneer Lay Minister in the Church of England.

### Latest news from Ann-Marie:

After a very busy 2018, we are easing back into the New Year with new plans and strategies. The end of 2018 was very busy with many events both in the UK and overseas.

The launch of our FGM and The Law reports went extremely well and we have seen much positive press on this. The reports are already being used in Kenya and Nigeria to support court cases against the practice.

We were thrilled to receive an award for the 'Best Collaborative Project' from Thomas Reuters Foundation at an award ceremony in New York in September. We also trained the US Border Force and FBI whilst in New York and Washington.

We are forging ahead with our law work to help create a model law template for use in countries which do not currently have an anti-FGM law in place. This is exciting and ground-breaking work, which we know is already influencing the lives of many girls and women across the world.

As well as New York, we spoke at: the Press Red Conference in Manchester; the Soroptimist International Conference in Liverpool; a strategic Home Office summit in London; New Wine Women Leaders' Conference in Northamptonshire; and CMS Africa conference in Derbyshire.
