Annette Goddard (nee Jandrell) has worked with Youth with a Mission (YWAM) since 2000; she spent 8 years in Cambodia and has been based in Harpenden, England, for the past 10 years. The aim of her ministry is: 'To see communities transformed and released from poverty into the abundant life that God intends for them'. She does this by leading a 6 month Community Development School (CDS), which equips and prepares participants from developing countries for community development ministry in their own communities. She also runs Community Development seminars at different YWAM locations in the world. Last summer. Annette married Martyn Goddard.

Latest news from Annette:

Martyn and I went to Togo in September as I was running the 12 week Community Development School (CDS) lecture phase there. We came back for Christmas in December so that we could celebrate our first Christmas as a married couple together in the UK. I am thankful that the lecture phase was successful. All five students, from five different nations, chose to do their Field Assignment together in Ivory Coast. They started this in the middle of January and it will last for three months.

I have four Community Development Seminars planned for 2019 so far; one in The Netherlands, one in India, and two in the UK. I am trying to develop a network so that I can get more opportunities to run the Community Development Seminar, either for a week or for an extended period of time.

Martyn is actively looking for employment, but has been unsuccessful to date. We continue to ask God to guide us regarding our future life and ministry, and where to live.
