### Student Outreach in Belgium

Chris Alexander, Luke Graham and Pete Grant go to Belgium on 17 March for a week. They will be staying with local students from a Christian Union group (Icthus) and supporting them to run a student outreach week.

### Women's trip to Kenya

A team of 8 women are going to Kenya from 29 March to 8 April. They will be supporting St Bs' Mission Partners Bernie and Celia Mascher in the *Little Hands School* they run - a nursery and primary school which integrates children with physical disabilities. They will be sharing resources and ideas with the teachers, supporting children with disabilities, helping to set up a library, and generally mucking in wherever they are needed.

- For smooth and easy final preparations for each team member
- For safe travelling and good health and energy for the team
- For good relationships amongst the St Bs team and with the Little Hands School teachers/team
- For sensitivity to Kenyan culture and really good connections with the children at the school
- That each St Bs team member finds a place to serve that really matches their gifting and skills, but also takes them out of their comfort zone
- For reliance on God as they serve
- That God will speak to each team member while they are in Kenya about how they can apply what they have learnt once the trip is over

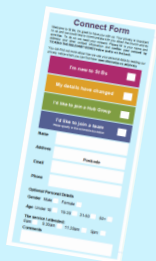
