The Gray family: Malcolm, Kerstin and their daughter Amy moved to the UK a year ago, having spent 16 years working with WEC International in Thailand. They are now working from the WEC office in Coventry, preparing to take on their new role as Directors of WEC UK & Ireland.

Latest news from the Grays:

"As we prepare to take on our new role as UK directors of WEC, we are on a steep learning curve, with lots of hand-over, including numerous trips to UK WEC members in their various contexts – it's great to see the bigger picture, and there are still many places to visit.

Amy is doing really well at school, with the teachers appreciative for her helpful attitude and willingness to learn in class.

Malcolm underwent a significant, planned operation to his chest a month ago at St Bartholomew's Hospital. This included putting metal bars in his chest. Whilst the operation went well, Malcolm has since had increasing discomfort, pain, fever and breathlessness.

Last Tuesday Malcolm was taken to A&E in Coventry where after fluid was drained from his lungs, he was able to breathe normally again. However he is still on oxygen and at the time of writing it is planned to transfer him to Barts Hospital in London. Kerstin will stay with friends in London so she can visit; and Amy will spend the beginning of her school holidays with Malcolm's parents in Bristol until they know how Malcolm is and when he will be able to return home."

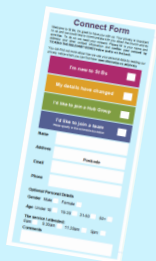
