They run a busy and demanding guest house, called Beit Immanuel, and have the responsibility for three congregations that meet there: a Messianic Jewish congregation (approximately 50% Russian), an Arabic congregation, and an Armenian congregation. Annu is developing a counselling ministry.

Latest news from Pedro and Annu:

There has been an amazing increase in the numbers of visitors, both Jews and Arabs, in Beit Immanuel. Their first words usually are: "There is such a nice atmosphere in this place. What is this?" That is the open door for us to share about our faith in Jesus. The Passover/Easter week brought a lot of people.

We recently invited people to Beit Immanuel to donate blood (a very important thing) and were able to share about "the blood that can really save lives". It went really well.

In May I (Pedro) will be in Brazil speaking at a conference in the Bible College I studied in around 34 years ago. I am also looking forward to spending some quality time with my family, especially with my mother (85) who I will be able to be with on Brazilian Mother's Day.

We have just received another answer about our license and it is very positive. God is super good!

Our Congregation is in a very good place in every area. Our Senior Pastor is retiring and passing the baton to our Assistant Pastor, which means that I will be taking on more responsibilities as I assist in the process.

Sadly, we are going through some difficult patches with CMJ's leadership. Our enemy never sleeps and is always trying to bring division.

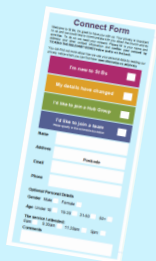
