#### Latest news from Kerry:

For the past 2-3 months, the rest of my team has been away, so it was good to have Rosie Hughes visiting me for 2 weeks recently. I am so thankful to World Mission Support (WMS) for helping to make this happen. It was great to have someone from home to see what we are doing. My team will all be back in Cameroon together by mid-May. so we will be 5 again instead of just me! We especially want to spend more time in training Cameroonians to reach out to Muslims with the Gospel.

Recently I had a very encouraging visit to our hospital in the north of Cameroon, and met with some of the Fulbe believers there. Things continue to run well at the hospital with lots of patients still coming. Some of the Fulbe believers are being intentional about sharing the Gospel with others. I met J again and her husband - it seems that he now wants to know Jesus too!

Ramadan started on 6 May and this is never an easy month to find open hearts to Jesus.

MT & N are now the proud parents of a son. As per custom, there was a naming ceremony at 8 days old. In front of all his male relatives and friends, MT read 2 Psalms and the Aaronic blessings from Numbers 6 from his Arabic Bible. This was a bold step for MT as he has not vet announced to his family that he is following Jesus.

- That the Fulbe believers will stand firm in Christ, love him more deeply, boldly share the gospel with others and become fruitful disciple makers
