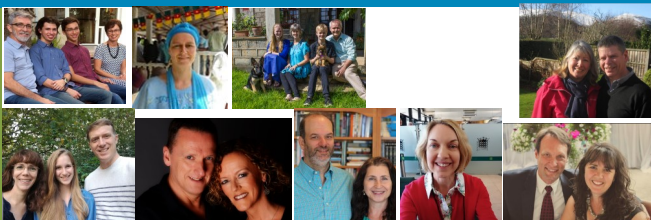




St Bs Mission Partners
