Lily, the youngest of the four Peachey children, is currently on the outreach phase of her DTS (Discipleship Training School) in Peru and is really seeing God at work.

Back in the UK, John, Suzi and the rest of the Peachey family came to St Bs two weeks ago on World Mission Sunday/Pentecost Sunday. John preached in the morning services, with some input from Suzi and their other daughter, Naomi. They inspired us from Acts 2 and their own missional experiences in the UK and overseas.

John continues to work hard on his PhD.
