About Malcolm and Kerstin Gray:

Malcolm, Kerstin and their daughter Amy moved the UK 16 months ago, after having spent more than 15 years working with WEC International in Thailand. They are now living in Coventry, close to the WEC UK headquarters and are Directors elect of WEC UK & Ireland, due to start officially in September.

Latest news from the Grays:

Malcolm had an operation on his chest at St Bartholomew's Hospital in March, where he had metal bars put in behind the sternum (breast bone) to push it into a normal position. Since then, he has been in and out of hospital in Coventry and London with various complications, including excruciating pain, temperature spikes, a fast heart rate, breathlessness and fluid on his lung and around his heart. Following various investigations over several weeks, an infection on a small part of one of the metal bars has been diagnosed. Malcolm is now home where he continues to receive treatment and is still experiencing a lot of pain and tiredness.

Kerstin has been supporting Malcolm and Amy, and going back into the WEC office on a daily basis to learn and prepare as much as she can for the Director role that she and Malcolm are due to take on in September.

Amy finished her school exams a week ago and breaks up for the summer holidays next week.

The house in Thornbury, which belongs to Malcolm's parents, has recently been sold subject to contract, and the offer they made for a house in the North of Coventry has been accepted!

Give thanks:

- That the cause of Malcolm's temperature spikes has been found
- That God has helped Kerstin get through the past few months
- For leading the Grays to a house that they can see themselves in, and that their offer has been accepted

Please pray:

- That Malcolm will make a full recovery
- That Kerstin will be able to think clearly, sleep at night, not feel too stressed and be able to support Malcolm and Amy
- That Amy will stay well and strong and have a good end of term at school
- That the sale of the Thornbury house and purchase of the Coventry house will go through smoothly
- That Malcolm and Kerstin will be able officially to take over the role of WEC UK & Ireland Directors as planned in September

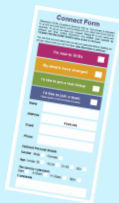
If you are a newcomer and would like more information, then please take and complete one of our **Connect Forms**, which you will find at the connect point or in the Offering Baskets as they come round.
