Ann-Marie Wilson is the founding Executive Director of the charity *28 Too Many* which has the ambitious goal of reducing Female Genital Mutilation (FGM) by 10% in 10 countries in 10 years. She is also a Pioneer Lay Minister in the Church of England.

The summer began with a hip operation and much needed recovery and recuperation; Ann-Marie was blessed with wonderful helpers and visitors during her convalescence.

FGM is increasingly on the public agenda and *28 Too Many* has received several awards for their #NoFGM Ribbon campaign. They launched their Social Norms report at the beginning of the summer and will be taking this and a Law report to the UN in October. Hopefully these will influence policy makers and help make meaningful changes.

They are also celebrating the launch of NHS FGM clinics in the UK to help even more women and girls, and have had opportunities to share their work on both stage and screen, reaching out to more people to support the cause.
