They run a busy and demanding guest house called Beit Immanuel, which reaches out to the local Jewish and Arab people. They also have responsibility for three congregations that meet there. Annu is developing a counselling ministry.

Latest news from Pedro and Annu:

In September, we took part in Open Houses, a three day event promoted by the Tel Aviv Municipality. During this time, thousands of Israelis visited Beit Immanuel and we had many deep conversations about the Messiah, some hearing about him for the first time in their lives!

We are getting close to finalising everything with the Water Department. Hopefully by November our sprinkler system will be functional.

David Lazarus, our Congregation pastor for the past 30 years, has retired and passed the leadership on to Aleksey Raichstadt.

We are both in the UK at the moment visiting and speaking at many Jewish congregations on behalf of CMJ.
