Helping Hands, which offers vocational training courses such as weaving. and a leadership/theological diploma to church leaders. They also run Little Hands School which integrates children with physical disabilities and other special needs.

Latest news from the Maschers:

The last quarter of the year has been quite tough for the Helping Hands school. In September they took a group of children with special needs on an outing. One of the little boys with autism managed to slip past his carers and disappeared. Tragically he drowned in the nearby river, which has been devastating for the school team and the family.

Thankfully, the school year ended on a positive note: the pre-primary children had a special graduation day and celebration

Abbie and Theon's Canadian citizenship has been confirmed. Abbie is thinking about going to university in Canada, so this is a huge answer to prayer!
