John and Suzi Peachey serve with Youth with A Mission (YWAM) in Harpenden. They teach and mentor younger missionary leaders, and help facilitate the group of senior leaders caring for YWAM teams in England. They lead the ministry of *Orphans Know More* which is strengthening Ugandan families who have adopted orphans. Their four young adult children are Seth, Joel, Naomi and Lily.

Latest news from the Peachey family:

John has nearly finished his PhD in Education through the Oxford Centre for Mission Studies and Middlesex University. His final viva is on 10 February at 11am in Oxford: the end is in sight!

Orphans Know More families have started four primary schools seeking to provide Christian education in rural areas.

Their daughter Naomi's No Make Up November raised £8,000 for girls education in Uganda. Individuals girls set up their own Just Giving Pages, while participants reported how much it helped them to learn to love their natural looks.
