Ann-Marie Wilson is the founding Executive Director of the charity *28 Too Many* which has the ambitious goal of reducing Female Genital Mutilation (FGM) by 10% in 10 countries in 10 years. She is also a Pioneer Lay Minister in the Church of England.

Latest news from Ann-Marie:

2020 started with a key date: the International Day of Zero Tolerance for FGM on 6 February. The #NoFGM ribbon that *28 Too Many* launched last year was worn around the world on this day. More information at www.nofgmribbon.info

Ann-Marie's health is an on-going challenge; she is currently wearing a funky boot and crutches for a broken foot due to a fall following an eye sight crisis in December.

In March, Ann-Marie will travel to the United Nations in New York to launch their Model Law report. This year marks the 25th anniversary of the Beijing Declaration, and although much has been done to improve women's rights around the world, there is still a lot of work to do.
