Pedro & Annu Santos work with CMJ in Tel Aviv. Israel. They run a busy and demanding quest house called Beit Immanuel and have the responsibility for three congregations that meet there. These include a Messianic Jewish congregation which is approximately 50% Russian, an Arabic congregation, and an Armenian congregation. Annu is also developing a

counselling ministry. Their sons are Daniel and Yonatan.

Latest news from Pedro and Annu:

In December we had two Christmas dinners with around 30 people each time in our home to share the story about Jesus. We are preparing a group of new believers to be baptized this spring and had the privilege of speaking to a group of Holocaust survivors, many of whom showed genuine interest to come to our service on Fridays.

Last month there was an incredible gathering in Galilee where 600 Arabs and Jews came together to worship Jesus: absolutely wonderful!

Pedro recently returned from a 10 day visit to the US, sharing about the work we do in several churches. Our son Yonatan is planning to study International Law at the university of Edinburgh once he has completed his army service.

Looking back over this passing year, we have so many occasions to be in awe of our great God. Thank you so much for your support and prayers!
