Latest news from the Grays:

This has been an interesting season for the family. On 5 February, Kerstin started an 18 week course of chemotherapy as ongoing treatment for breast cancer. On 14 February, Malcolm had surgery to remove metalwork previously inserted into his chest which had become infected, while Amy had to watch her parents go through all these health scares.

At this point, Kerstin has been coping with the ups and downs of chemo, Malcolm is making a good recovery and Amy is commendably getting on with school life preparing for exams. Their WEC team in Coventry is looking after the Grays and carrying extra responsibilities during their medical leave.

WEC is partnering with OM and other mission agencies to host the Logos Hope ship in 5 ports around the UK. The ship will be in London from 15 October to 5 November.
